Considerations for Successful Remote Audit

- Audit Type & Profile sensitivity, known issues, proportion of work as human contact, need for physical inspections
- Sponsorship and support from Client to formally reinforce auditors remote approach
- Operator commitment and buy-in to receiving remote audit
- Operator attitude historically to JV audit, "spirit" of approach in line with industry best practice
- Pre-existing relationship with Operator staff from prior audits
- Access to key Operator and Client staff
- Audit coordinator committed and available for a "normal working week"
- Ability to stick to framework, opening and closing meetings etc., daily updates, IR response time
- Vouchers and contracts in electronic format
- Connectivity for location
- Use of TEAMS or equivalent to basic level. Folder structure, upload of documents, chat, meetings
- Time zone
